THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby recognize December 1, 2018, as the 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF ROMANIA'S GREAT UNION, join in honoring Georgia citizens

of Romanian heritage, and extend my best wishes to Romania and her people for a peaceful,

prosperous, and successful future.
